Paphiopedilums

Complex Hybrids

There are many good reasons for growing this genus and the complex types in particular. The complex hybrids offer the home grower ease of culture. Complex Paphiopedilums grow and flower very well under low light requirements. These plants produce large flowers that last for a month or longer and are stunning accents in the home.



HV-793 (Paph. Sarella 'Marsala' HCC/AOS x Leather 'Princess' HCC/AOS)

These are blooming in a variety of colors. Some are green with violet brush marks on the dorsal and petals. Others are a nice shade of rose all with nice full dorsals that are flat. The photo shows a first bloom seedling.

HV-857 Paph. (Gege Hughes (Hellas 'Westonbirt' FCC/RHS x Halo 'Sunshine'))

Remake of a superb cross that produced big round flowers in apricot peach to honey-yellow tones. These will have good size. The Halo is a wonderful all yellow flower. Photo shows color type.

HV-859 Paph (Hellas 'Westonbirt' FCC/RHS x Valime 'Irish King' HCC/AOS)

Large full greens, yellows, and peach colored flowers on tall stems. These should be much like the Paph. Valerie Tonkin cross that produced so many fine flowers. The Valime is a huge flower with excellent form. Photo shows a first bloom seedling.

**HV-861 Paph. (Spotglen 'Doodlebug' HCC/AOS x Duncan York 'Southard' AM/AOS)**

Very large bright reds with black spotting. A few all red flowers have flowered from this grex as well. The cherry red color from Paph. Spotglen 'Doodlebug' should add more color to the petals and pouch. The highest quality can be expected here. Photo shows a first bloom seedling from this grex. One Award of Merit on this cross so far!

**HV-864 Paph. (Normandy 'Odin' HCC/AOS x Spotglen 'Doodlebug' HCC/AOS)**

Large spotted reds and red browns of excellent quality! We are excited about using the Paph. Spotglen. It has the most amazing cherry red blaze of color that surrounds the flower. The Paph. Normandy is a well-known breeder. Photo shows a first bloom seedling from this grex.

**HV-867 Paph. (Milionette 'Bagdad' AM/AOS x W.N. Evans 'Rose Queen' AM/AOS)**

Dark reds of medium to large size flowers. The W. N. Evans has been around for a long time. Not a large flower but with good round form and excellent red color. We hope the size of the Milionette will prevail. Photo-Paph. Milionette 'Bagdad' AM/AOS

**HV-869 Paph. (London Wall 'Fairfield' B/CSA x Agincourt 'San Carlos' AM/AOS)**

Tall greens and yellows with dark spotting on the dorsal. Paph. London Wall seedlings are known for their large flowers and ability in breeding. These will be gigantic! Photo shows a first bloom seedling from this grex.

**HV-870 Paph. (((Van Ness x Small World) x Duncan York) x Thunder Bay 'Flash' AM/AOS)**

Both parents used here are exceptional spotted reds. Look for more of the same. The first parent has the most incredible full dorsal we have seen. These flowers will have excellent form and lots of spotting in the dorsal. Photo shows color type.

**HV-880 Paph. Luther Pass (Spotglen 'Doodlebug' HCC/AOS x Winston Churchill 'Redoubtable' FCC/AOS)**

Very high potential here for outstanding spotted reds with super size and shape! The Spotglen glows with red color in the petals and base of the flower. The photo to the right shows a first bloom seedling from this grex. Nice color with some all red flowers without spotting, many will be spotted. My favorite cross of the season!

**HV885 Paph. (Limerick 'Hillsview' HCC/AOS x Golden Acres 'Go Boy' AM/AOS)**

The Limerick is one of our favorite greens. The Golden Acres has been used to produce some very fine greens in the past. We expect good quality all green flowers here. Photo shows a first bloom seedling from this grex.

**HV-886 Paph. (Limerick 'Hillsview' HCC/AOS x Shapely Carlene 'Guacamole')**

This grex and the following are reciprocal and as such are the same. It will be interesting to see if one is better than the other, although one would expect very similar results. Both are producing some fine green flower, some with peppering on the dorsal. Photo shows a first bloom seedling from this grex.

**HV-887 Paph. (Shapely Carlene 'Guacamole' x Limerick 'Hillsview' HCC/AOS)**

Several have been selected by the hybridizer for future breeding. These are quite a pleasant surprise, as the quality is better than expected. Nice shaped all green flowers, some with peppering on the dorsal. Photo shows a first bloom seedling from this grex.

**HV-888 Paph. (Limerick 'Hillsview' HCC/AOS x (Wallur x Cherokee) 'Grande')**

The Paph. (Wallur x Cherokee) 'Grande' is over half a foot across and is a clear green that fades to yellow/green. One of the first to flower received an AM/AOS quality award as seen in the photo of the reciprocal cross below. We expect awards here as well. Photo shows a first bloom seedling from this grex.

**HV-889 Paph. ((Wallur x Cherokee) 'Grande' x Limerick 'Hillsview' HCC/AOS)**

This is the reciprocal of the previous cross HV-888. The first to flower have been very nice all green flowers with a fine white border around the dorsal. Photo shows a first bloom seedling that just received an AM/AOS quality award!

**HV-890 Paph. (Limerick 'Hillsview' HCC/AOS x Greenvale 'Hillsview')**

Paph. Greenvale 'Hillsview' was selected from a flask acquired many years ago, from John Hanes. It was a remake of the original cross. This was the best seedling selected from that flask, and is a very fine all green flower that is producing first rate flowers! The photo to the right shows a first bloom seedling from this grex.

**HV-902 Paph. (Sharnden 'Agnes Miller' HCC/AOS x (Milmoore x Redsand) 'Hillsview')**

Paph. Sharnden has bright red petals and pouch with a nice spotted dorsal. The (Milmoore x Redsand), 'Hillsview', has a spectacular large flat dorsal with lots of dark almost black spotting. We expect some wonderful big sail like dorsals with blackish spotting and nice dark red petals and pouch. The photo shows a first bloom seedling from this grex.

**HV-906 Paph. (Milionette 'Bagdad' AM/AOS x Keyeshill 'Magnificat')**

Big all red flowers here! The Keyeshill 'Magnificat' has the most unusual glossy red color... We are hoping the tall flower stems of Milionette are expressed here. We are always looking for true red colored flowers. Photo shows a first bloom seedling from this grex.

HV-909 Paph. (Beaute 'Linda' B/CSA x (Venture 'Sunny Glow' HCC/AOS x Winston Churchill 'Indomitable' FCC/AOS) 'Roseville')

Paph. Beaute has been used to produce some very fine complex paphs. Paired with the **huge** 'Roseville', we expect some very large spotted complex paphs. Photo shows a first bloom seedling from this grex. With all the awarded parents, how can you go wrong!

HV-895 Paph. (Gigi 'Malibu' AM/AOS x Greenvale 'Hillsview')

Paph. Gigi 'Malibu' is legend in breeding complex Paphiopedilums. It will give large well formed flowers and will take on much of the color of the other parent. These will be honey green colored flowers with very good size and shape. Photo shows a first bloom seedling from this grex!

HVT03 Paph. (Magic Mountain (Peter Black 'Emerald' AM/AOS x Denehurst 'Surprise' AM/AOS))

These are huge in every way. Expect 11.5 cm to 12 cm flowers. The colors will be butterscotch yellow with some green suffusion on the dorsal. A great Remake! Photo shows a first bloom seedling from this grex.

HVT04 Paph. (Divisidero 'Val' HCC/AOS x Greenvale 'Hillsview')

Greenvale 'Hillsview' is one of our favorite all green complex paphs. Divisidero 'Val' HCC/AOS has a nice tall spike with dark green flowers. We hope for some very nice all green flowers on tall stems.

Brachypetalum and Maudiae Type

These two groups of plants are very popular, The Brachypetalums are smaller plants with beautiful thick foliage mottled in silver and dark green. The maudiae type is very easy to grow and have a patchwork pattern of light and dark green mottled foliage. Both types offer compact plant habit with mottled foliage. They are always attractive even when not in flower.



HV-878 Paph. (Greyi 'Roxanne' x S. Gratrix 'Full Moon')

These are full white flowers with lots of rose peppering, stunning brachypetalum hybrid here. The foliage on these plants is always attractive with interesting patterns of light and dark green mottling. Photo shows a first bloom seedling.

HV-884 Paph. Macabre (sukhakulii 'Fat Boy' x Voodoo Magic 'Dr. Bombay')

A remake of the most highly awarded Paphiopedilum. The sukhakulii is the largest clone we have seen. The Voodoo Magic is a big flat flower with much color. These have been large with super form and color. Photo shows a first bloom seedling.

**HAK-743 Paph. (Red Maude x Shin Yi Pie)**

Flame vinicolors on tall stems. Flowers will be held very high above the foliage in flame vinicolors and dark coloratum shades of rose red, and lots of black spots on the wide petals. These are huge!

**HV-883 Paph. (Emerald Alba x Candy Apple 'Big Top')**

These are blooming in both albas, coloratum, and vinicolors. Flowers are large with much of the shape of the Candy Apple. We made this cross to give size to the albas using this huge Candy Apple. Photo shows first bloom seedling.

**HV-915 Paph. Maudiae ('Los Osos' AM/AOS x 'Hillsview')**

Outcross of two very fine clones. Maudiae 'Los Osos' AM/AOS is legend in the world of paph breeding. The Maudiae 'Hillsview' is a dark colored clone from vinnicolor breeding. We expect some nice dark forms here.

Masdevallias

Masdevallias are orchids endemic to South and Central America, north into Mexico. Most are cool growing, and thus appropriate plants for Pacific Northwest collections. There is, however, a range of temperature tolerance, and one of our breeding objectives is to increase this range in our hybrids, as is evident in the following listing. We continue to offer outcrosses of selected species where possible and continue our interest in Masdevallia coccinea, color forms.

**HV-995 Masd. Raymondo Delos Andes (uniflora x macrura 'Dark')**

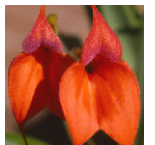
Remake of a cross we did some years ago. We expect the quality to be as good as the original grex. The flowers are the most wonderful shade of blue-violet with lots of character.

2.25" pot Near Blooming Size \$ 17.00

**HV-1000 Masd. Charisma (yungasensis 'Peppermint' AM/AOS x coccinea alba 'Greentree' AM/AOS)**

Remake of a stunning candy striped hybrid. White flowers with red to violet candy stripes. These are very floriferous. Cool growers.

2.25" pot Near Blooming Size \$ 17.00

**HV-1001 Masd. Celine Dion reg. 1993 (Masd. welischii 'Rip-Hoff' AM/AOS x coccinea 'Lestat')**

A remake of a very nice cross from Highland Tropical. The coccinea 'Lestat' was selected from an outcross of two bright reds. The Masd. welischii is a well know cultivar and is expected to give upright spike habit. Flowers should be in orange to red colors.

2.25" pot Near Blooming Size \$ 17.00

**HV-1002 Masd. Rebecca reg. 1893 (amabilis 'Ray Bob' x ignea 'Valentine')**

A remake of a cross not seen in 100 years! These are blooming in red to violet shades with darker stripping. The colors here are just unbelievable! The spikes are very straight and upright, much like Masd. amabilis. A nice habit with some of the Masdevallias not possessing a stronger spike.

2.25" pot Near Blooming Size \$ 17.00

**HV-1003 Masd. Fraseri reg. 1882 (ignea 'Fourth of July' x coccinea 'Maryann')**

This remake of an exceptional standard Masdevallia hybrid. The flowers are bright fire engine red and even some orange-reds, very bright colors! The Masd. ignea used here is from our outcross that produced some outstanding cultivars. The coccinea is a jungle collected plant and is a stunning red. Expect some awards here! This is the best thing we have seen blooming on the bench in some time.

2.25" pot Near Blooming Size \$ 17.00

**HV-1004 Masd. Redwing reg. 1985 (coccinea 'Lines' CBM/AOS x infracta 'Ruby')**

Another remake, these are all blooming in deep red colors. Masd. coccinea 'Lines' is the most wonderful orange-red flower, it should have a quality award. The infracta 'Ruby' is a very dark form with flowers larger than the type species. Photo shows a recently awarded clone from this grex Masd. Redwing 'Premiere' HCC/AOS

**HV-1012 Masd. Jerry Sedenko reg. 2001 (Freckles 'Hillsview' x Hortensia 'Dark Leopard')**

Remake of a colorful hybrid with lots of variety. Sold out the last time it was offered! Flowers are larger versions of Masd. decumana but in a variety of colors. A very floriferous little hybrid that covers the plant with spikes in the early spring. Expect some award here.

Terms

Payment: Payment must accompany your order by **check, Visa, MasterCard or Paypal available in our online catalog. Make checks payable to Hillsview Gardens.** All orders are filled on a first come first serve bases. Your credit card will be charged when your order is placed to secure all your plants.

Domestic Shipments: Orders will be queued for shipping in order received. We ship on Monday through Wednesday of each week. Charges for shipping and packing are as follows;

1. If your order is \$100.00 or less, add \$ 15.00 for packing and shipping.
2. If your order is over \$100.00 add 15% to your order.
3. If you are ordering online your shipping will be calculated for you.

Our choice for shipping domestic orders is via Priority Air and Federal Express.

Federal Express choices are as follows;

1. FedEx Express Saver - Third Business Day
2. FedEx 2Day - Second Business Day
3. FedEx Standard Overnight - Next Business Afternoon
4. FedEx Priority Overnight - Next Business Morning

(Express saver being the least costly)

We ship year round however we reserve the right to delay shipping when temperatures are extreme and may cause damage to plants in transit. We also use thermal packing during the winter months.

Hawaii, Puerto Rico, Virgin Islands and Guam orders: Please include your import permit number with your order, if required. There is a charge of \$10.00 for State of Oregon Phytosanitary Certificates on all orders going to Hawaii. Please allow 2 weeks for shipping schedule due to inspections. Priority air and FedEx are preferred.

International orders: Payments should be made by bank draft on a U.S. bank, wire transfer, or by Visa, MasterCard. It is the responsibility of our international customers to supply any documentation required by your government. There is a charge of \$10 for State of Oregon phytosanitary certificates, required for Federal Phyto. Please allow three weeks for scheduling international orders. Please advise preferred method of shipping. Unless you request otherwise, we will ship Express Mail Service. Please include 20% of order value for shipping and handling. If shipping charges exceed this amount or if we ship airfreight we will bill you at cost. Please indicate if insurance is desired and include \$3 per \$100 up to \$400. Not all postal shipments to foreign countries are insurable. Plants not insured or insured at less than full value travel at the buyer's risk. Airfreight shipments can be insured to full value. Insurance covers only complete loss of shipment and not damage through mishandling or time delay. Fed-Ex international shipping is advised. Overseas shipments and Canadian Shipments will be sent bare-root.

| All international orders must add:

\$10 for Oregon State Phytosanitary Certificate.

\$30 for Federal Phytosanitary Certificate on orders up to \$1250.

\$50 for Federal Phytosanitary Certificate on orders over \$1250.

The minimum value for international orders is \$250. All shipping is billed at cost.

Damaged Shipments: We take care in packing your order. If damage is evident upon receipt of order, please keep all packaging material and plants and please report the damage to us immediately. We may request the return of damaged items.
